

# Brought Out to Be Brought In

- Deuteronomy 6:23 Then He **brought us out** from there, that He **might bring us in**, to give us the land of which He swore to our fathers.
- Phil.3:12 Not that I have now attained [this ideal], or have already been made perfect, but I press on to lay hold of (grasp) and make my own, that for which Christ Jesus (the Messiah) has laid hold of me and made me His own.
- 1) He brought us out by His Hand

- Ex.3:20-21 So I will **stretch out My hand** and **strike Egypt** with all My wonders which I will do in its midst; and after that he will **let you go**. And I will give this people **favour** in the sight of the Egyptians; and it shall be, when you go, that you shall not **go empty-handed**.
- 1Sam.7:13-14 **And the hand of the LORD** was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel. <sup>14</sup> **Then** the cities which the Philistines had taken from Israel were **restored** to Israel, from Ekron to Gath; and Israel **recovered its territory** from the hands of the Philistines. Also there was peace between Israel and the Amorites.

- Ex.13:3 And Moses said to the people:  
“Remember this day in which you went out of Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of **hand the LORD** brought you out of this *place*.
- Eph.2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.
- 2) God stretched out His hand when Moses did

- **Ex.3:20** I will **stretch out My hand** and strike Egypt with all My wonders which I will do in its midst; and after that he will let you go.
- Ex. 7:19 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, “Say to Aaron, ‘**Take your rod and stretch out your hand** over the waters of Egypt,
- Ex.8:6 So Aaron **stretched out his hand** over the waters of Egypt, and the frogs came up...
- Prov.18:21 Death and life *are* in the **power** of the tongue... (*yad - hand*) - ability to accomplish a task - the hand as a body part which is essential to manipulate one’s environment

- 3) Brought in by His Hand
- Ps.44:3 For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, nor did their **own arm** save them; But it was Your right **hand**, Your **arm**, and the light of Your countenance, because You favoured them.
- Numbers 13:1 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, “Send men to spy out the land of Canaan, which I am giving to the children of Israel; from each tribe of their fathers you shall send a man, every one a leader among them.”

- The 12 spies – rulers, heads or leaders
- **Shammau** – *renowned – annihilation*
- **Shaphat** – *to judge or deliver rule*
- **Caleb** – *dog*
- **Igal** – *He redeems*
- **Joshua** – *salvation, deliver*
- **Palty** – *my deliverance*
- **Gaddiel** – *God is my fortune, do great things*
- **Gaddi** – *my fortune, great dignity*
- **Ammiel** – *my kinsmen is God,*

- **Sethur** - hidden, the idea of protection
- **Nahbi** – *hidden, rest, absence of disturbance from external causes*
- **Geuel** – *majesty of God, He has triumphed*
- 4) The failure of the arm of the flesh
- Num.13:27-28 Then they told him, and said: “We went to the land where you sent us. It truly flows with milk and honey, and this *is* its fruit. But the people who dwell in the land *are* strong; the cities *are* fortified *and* very large; moreover we saw the descendants of Anak (*Giants*) there.

- 1Cor.1:26-27 “Take a good look, friends, at who you were when you got called into this life. I don't see many of "the brightest and the best" among you, not many influential, not many from high-society families. Isn't it obvious that God deliberately chose men and women that the culture overlooks and exploits and abuses, chose these "nobodies" to expose the hollow pretensions of the "somebodies"? That makes it quite clear that none of you can get by with blowing your own horn before God.

- 5) Battles are necessary to get to where you are going
- Deuteronomy 1:21 Look, the LORD your God has set the land before you; go up and **possess** it, as the LORD God of your fathers has spoken to you; do not fear or be discouraged.'
- Possess – inherit, dispossess, seize, take possession by force
- Joshua 1:3 Every place that the sole of your foot will **tread** upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. :

- Joshua 1:5 No man shall *be able to* stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. **I will not leave you nor forsake you.**
- Heb.13:5-6 For He Himself has said, *“I will never leave you nor forsake you.”* So we may boldly say: *“The LORD is my **helper**; I will not fear. What can man do to me?”*
- Helper – describes God as poised ready to to rush to the aid of His oppressed children when they cry to Him for help.

- Joshua 1:8-9 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. <sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God *is* with you wherever you go.”
